District responses will be noted with blue italic text.

- 1. In order to meet the financial statement requirements, firms are incurring substantial costs for their CPA to review the past 3 years of financials. Is it necessary for the firms to provide the financial statements on the CPA's letterhead?
 - a. The District wants to see financial statements in order to evaluate the financial stability of the company. It is preferred if these statements are submitted on a CPA's letterhead, it will not be required. However, the district will reserve the right to request this documentation later in the selection process, should it be deemed necessary.
- 2. Will the Survey; Geotechnical Reports; FFE Evaluation; and Asbestos Evaluations be the responsibility of the Architect?
 - a. No, these services will be provided by the Ontario School District.
- 3. When will the survey and soils report be available to the design team?
 - a. We will need to establish the proposed location of the new buildings before a survey and geotechnical report is completed.
- 4. Will the Data/Security/Projectors and Smart Boards be a part of the Architectural contract?
 - a. Data will be the responsibility of the Architect/Engineers.
 - b. The Ontario School District does not use Smart Boards
 - c. Projectors and all associated data and power will be required in all Classrooms.

- 5. Will the final selection be based on a cumulative score?
 - a. Yes, the presentation is worth 25 points, which is added to the total scores calculated from the technical proposal and price proposal evaluations; for a cumulative final score. The firm with the highest cumulative score will be selected.
- 6. What is meant by "Student Support Systems" on the Middle School's Scope of work?
 - a. This is intended to mean, Administrative Offices.
- 7. The RFP references Fire Alarm upgrades within the High School, does this mean that the entire fire alarm system will require an upgrade?
 - a. The Fire Alarm Panel was updated 2 years ago to a 'Silent Night Panel'. However, any necessary upgrades required to meet state and local codes will be the design team's responsibility.
- 8. Will Electronic As-Built documentation be available for the design teams use?
 - a. No, some hard copies of as-built drawings are available for use; however no electronic as-builts exist.
