Slides	 slide on bottom only, feet first go up the ladder only line forms on the ground one person at a time on the slide and ladder 	share and take turns	line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows
Monkey Bars	 one hand on bars at all times go left to right stay below the bars stay a safe distance from the bars 	 share and take turns include everyone keep moving forward 	line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows
Field/West Wing Dip-	 hands, feet, body to self keep a safe distance from fence keep a safe distance from all drains keep a safe distance from each other when rolling or running in the dip stay in the boundary area 	 share and take turns include everyone ask permission of other students before chasing them or playing tag what belongs on the ground stays on the ground (sticks, grass, rocks, sand, etc) 	line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows
Balls and Other Equipment	 No throwing balls at others Balls can be bounced against brick walls only Have an adult help you get any balls kicked over the fence Be aware of games/activities 	 Balls must be shared Balls must be played with in the appropriate area Keep balls off the roof and within the fences 	 line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows Return equipment to the classroom area Play according to school rules

Soccer	 Play only in designated soccer area Play by soccer rules Maximum of ten players per game 	Keep body to self	line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows Return equipment to the classroom area
Football	 All football games will be "flag" football Maximum of ten players per game Play only in designated area Football rules will be followed Football tackling and rough play is not allowed 	Keep body to self	 line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows Return equipment to the classroom area
Tag	 no tackling or wrestling no climbing on fence hands, feet, body to self keep a safe distance from fence light touch within tag zone 	 share and take turns include everyone ask permission of other students before chasing them or playing tag 	 line up quickly and quietly when whistle blows Return equipment to the classroom area
