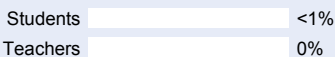

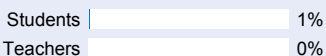

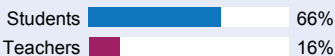

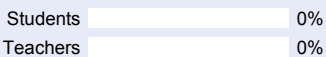

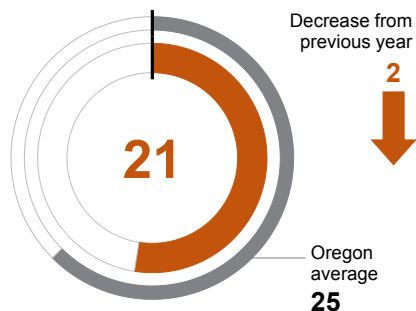

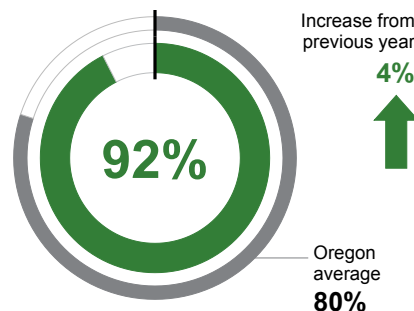

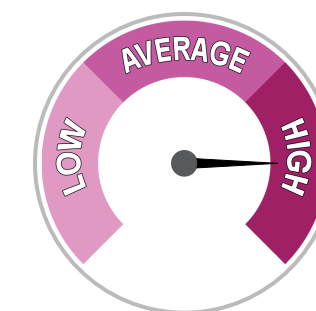

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

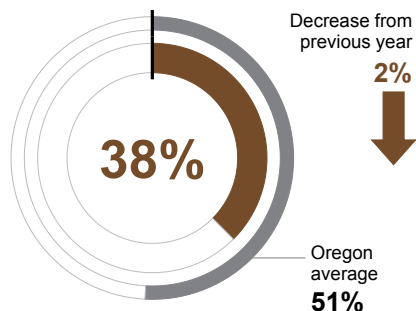
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

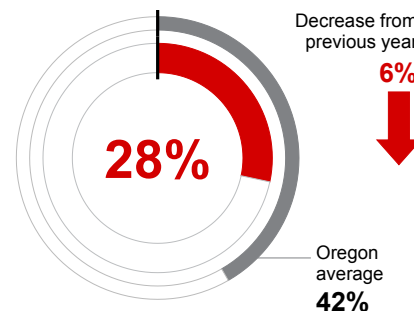
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

School Goals

At May Roberts, we support students to reach their full potential in all aspects of their lives including academic and social emotional wellness. To this end, we have worked very hard to ensure Multi-tiered Systems of Supports are in place and that decisions are being made in response to current academic, behavioral and attendance data. We continue to see strong growth in English Language Arts and Math. Our Regular Attenders rate is improving as well. We will continue to foster relationships with our families and community partners to ensure our students are supported to the fullest degree.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

At May Roberts, we strive to ensure all students and families feel welcomed and supported. We have trained our staff to be culturally responsive and to use trauma informed practices. We use multiple modes of communication including mail, phone, text, social media platforms and home visits. We always provide interpreters for any language needed. We have a full time parent involvement coordinator who works directly with families to support their needs and to provide meaningful opportunities for them to be involved in their children's education.

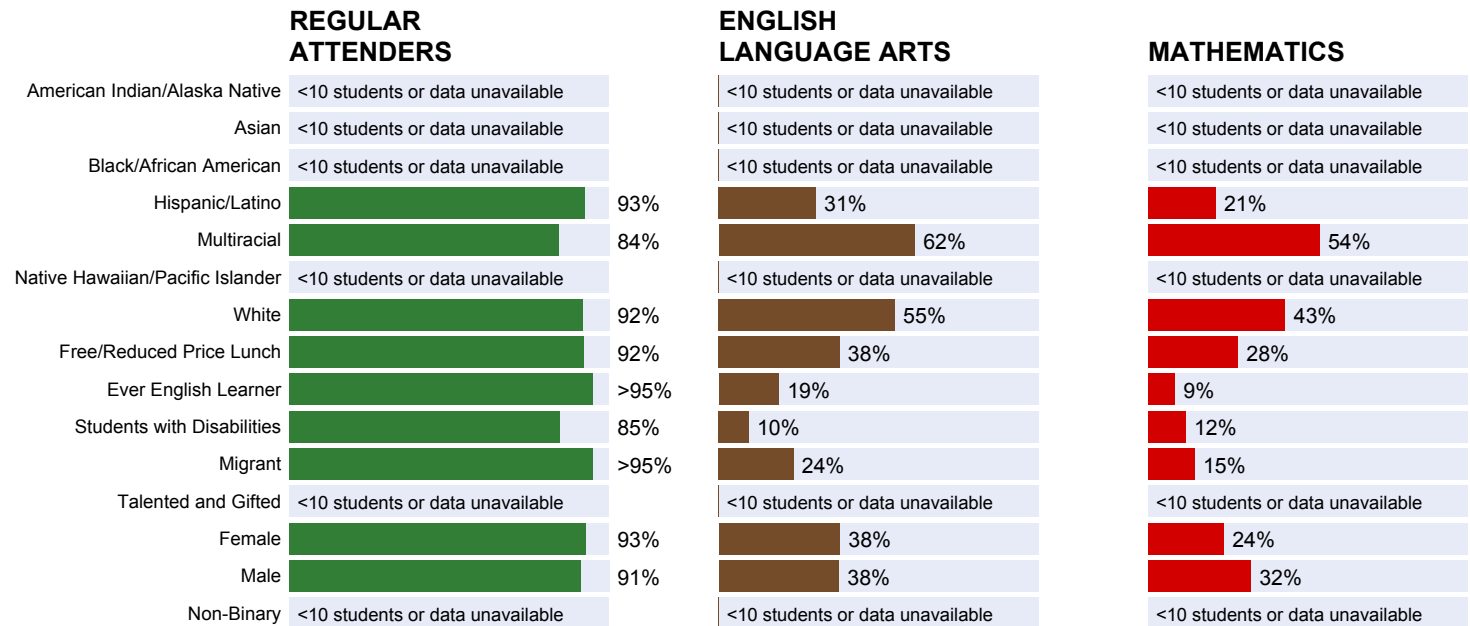

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

To ensure a safe and secure learning environment for all students, we implement Positive Behavior Intervention and supports (PBIS). We also use the Toolbox to help students with recognition, coping and self-regulation of their own emotions and feelings. We have a full time counselor who provides classroom lessons, small group and individual counseling support. We regularly review and rehearse our schoolwide expectations for behavior. We conduct regular evacuation and safety drills.
