SUMMARY: Provides active supervision on bus during route times to ensure student safety.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Actively supervises students in all areas of the bus
- 2. Develops professional relationships with students
- 3. Uses PBIS strategies to acknowledge adherence to rules
- 4. Displays objectivity and control when addressing behavior
- 5. Demonstrates value and respect for all students
- 6. Deescalates behaviors with proximity and stating of directions
- 7. Follows up with building and/or transportation administration regarding student behavior
- 8. Writes referrals when necessary
- 9. Communicates with bus driver as behaviors or concerns require
- 10. Provides opportunities for students to talk about their interests
