There was 1 restraint, all done by trained personnel (CPI).

There were no incidents of seclusions or seclusions in a locked room.

The total number of students placed in physical restraint was 1

There were no minor injuries to staff during restraint, predominately scratching or bruising, a total of 0 times.

No (0) student/s was restrained more than 10 times.

Our practice is that staff meet and, hold IEP or 504 meetings, review and revise the student's behavior plans, and work with families and outside providers to assist the students when restraints become necessary.
